

Rhythm Scavenger Hunt

Great for elementary to Senior as a form of Assessment OF Learning in a gamified manner.

Focus: Ear training

Steps to Facilitate

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| Step 1 Set-up | Import Bandology slides into your chosen PowerPoint platform (Microsoft PowerPoint or Google Slides). |
| Step 2 Set-up | Review the exemplar slides provided by Bandology (slide #6-12). Use these slides if they fit the learning goals of your class. If they do not, create new slides and add rhythms by copying rhythmic patterns from slide #10 to create any combination of rhythms with our template. |
| Step 2 | Go over the instructions on how to play the game with your students (slide #2). |
| Step 3 | To ensure the safety of all, go over the 'respect rules' (slide #3). |
| Step 4 | Play one of the rhythms/melodies on the slide (after 1-2 rounds, you can invite a student to choose a rhythm/melody to perform). Be sure to count in the bar so that students know what tempo you are performing at. The students need to identify which pattern you or the other student is performing and then do the action associated with the pattern. |

Set-up:

Bandology has provided a PPTX (PowerPoint) file attached for this activity. **Tailor the game for the grade and level of your students.** This file will work well with Microsoft PowerPoint and Google Slides.

To import the PPTX file into Google Slides:

1. Download the PPTX file onto your Google Drive or your computer
2. Create and open a new slide deck
3. Select "File" then "Import Slides"
4. Under "Presentations," find where the PPTX file is saved and double click on it. Alternatively, under "Upload," click and drag the PPTX file into the space or choose "Select a file from your device"
5. Select which slides you want to import then select "import"
