The non-profit organization also secured more sustainable financial resources and created multiple community materials for teachers, students, musicians, parents and youths. And thanks to the grant from OTF, Bandology has been able to continue its initiative despite the hardships of the COVID-19 pandemic.

"With this OTF grant, our organization has been able to implement and expand several projects, including a COVID-safe Band Camp for teens and children, Band Together, a monthly music hang for youth, and thrice-weekly Play A Gig performance opportunities," said Lisa Michaels, Executive Director and Co-Founder of Bandology. "We have also developed innovative music curriculum and focused on our organizational objectives and long-term sustainability."
