Arlen Major is the clarinet, oboe and saxophone section leader. Arlen is a music student at Wilfrid Laurier University and has just finished his first year in the clarinet performance program.

Kyla Paul is the French horn section leader. Kyla studies the French horn at Laurier and is going into her fourth year in the Music Therapy program.

Ryan Minten is the trombone, baritone and tuba sectional leader. Ryan is another Laurier student, studying the trombone and pursuing a Bachelor of Music in Music Education.

Max Lindsay is the percussion section leader. He recently graduated with his Honours Bachelor of Music in Percussion Performance from Laurier and has performed regularly in the region with groups such as NUMUS, the Stratford Symphony Orchestra and the Kitchener-Waterloo Chamber Orchestra.

Trevor Wagler is coming to camp as a guest conductor. Trevor is a freelance French horn player, conductor, composer and clinician. He is currently a teacher at the Renaissance School of the Arts and also holds part-time faculty positions at Laurier and the University of Waterloo.

Bandology's Band Camp runs in Kitchener/Waterloo from July 18-22 and also in Halton from July 11-15. Registration is open now for kids in grades 1-12 at bandology.ca/band-camps. There are options for kids with extensive music experience and those with no experience at all.
