Clarke is best known for his position as the Artistic Director of the Toronto Youth Wind Orchestra (TYWO) which he founded when he was still a high school student. The TYWO is considered a leading Canadian performance ensemble and has won multiple awards for its hard work and dedication.

Bandology will also be running two additional camps this summer. A new location in Guelph runs July 17-21 and the second annual Band Camp for the Kitchener-Waterloo area takes place from July 24-28.
