Music Camp Returns to Laurier for Fun-Filled March Break

March Break Music Camp runs March 10-14, 2025, at LAMA on the Wilfrid Laurier University campus. Camp programming focuses on a wide array of music styles as well as engaging educational games and activities. Taught by dedicated staff and music mentors, campers will get the opportunity to try out different instruments, take a field trip to the Faculty of Music and enjoy performances by trained musicians.
