Band Camp Returns to Guelph For a Music-Filled Week

Guelph, Ontario, June 2, 2025 – Bandology’s Band Camp is pleased to return to Guelph this summer with music-making opportunities for kids in grades 1-12. From July 28 to August 1, children and youth in Guelph will have a chance to blend summer fun with meaningful musical growth.

The summer camp offers a fun and educational experience for young musicians in grades 1-12 to strengthen their skills through hands-on workshops and group activities. Band Camp allows teens in grades 7 to 12 to rehearse and perform in a concert band setting, directed by experienced music educators, conductors and musicians. Band Camp Junior is designed for students in grades 1-6 and requires no prior musical experience, offering a fun introduction to a variety of instruments and music styles.

“It’s incredible to see how much campers grow—not just in their music skills, but also in the way they build confidence, teamwork and social skills through the activities we have at camp,” says Sandy Wright, Education Manager and Head of Programming at Bandology. “At the end of the week, kids take the stage to share everything they’ve learned with their friends and family. It’s a great way for everyone to come together and celebrate their hard work.”

Allen Carter will return to Bandology to serve as Music Director for the Guelph camp. Carter is a conductor and tubist with over thirty years of experience as a professional musician. He currently leads the Guelph Symphony Youth Orchestra and holds principal tuba positions with the Guelph Symphony Orchestra and Brantford Symphony Orchestra, among others.
