Local Band Camp to Add Second Week for Summer 2026

Oakville, Ontario, November 24, 2025 – Local music non-profit Bandology is delighted to announce that they will be adding a second week to their Band Camp Halton program. Band Camp, for grades 7-12, and Band Camp Junior, for grades 1-6, is a summer day camp that encourages creativity, collaboration and fun through music.

Bandology has been hosting their Band Camp in Halton since 2017 as a one week camp that takes place in July (in 2026, the week of July 20-24). In honour of their tenth summer of camp and following multiple requests for more camp weeks from families, they have decided to add an additional week of camp, this one to take place August 10-14, 2026.

“For years, we have heard from parents and campers alike, asking if there could be more camp, more time to enjoy music,” said Lisa Michaels, Executive Director of Bandology. “Since we take camp on the road and travel to different locations, we haven’t done it before. But our tenth anniversary seems like the perfect occasion!”

Youth in the Band Camp program (grades 7-12) come together to form a full concert band for the week. They are guided by experienced instructors as they build their musical skills through group rehearsals. Band Camp Junior (grades 1-6) focuses on hands-on musical activities, instrument exploration and fun group games. No prior music experience is required for the younger group. At the end of the week, campers perform a concert for family and friends.

“Band Camp is always such an exciting week for all involved,” said Julianna Rutledge, Innovation Manager at Bandology. “Since we’ve run camp in Halton for so long, we have a dedicated community of music lovers who support us and this week is really for them.”

Band Camp Halton takes place at King’s Christian Collegiate, located at 528 Burnhamthorpe Road W in north Oakville.

Registration is currently open for kids in grades 1-12 at bandology.ca. For families facing financial difficulties, subsidies up to 90% are available, as are discounts for families who sign up for multiple weeks of camp. Families are encouraged to reach out to camp@bandology.ca with any questions.
