## **Instrument Library Moves Location to Local Community Centre**

**Oakville, Ontario, April 20, 2026** – Local music non-profit Bandology has recently relocated their Instrument Lending Library to the Queen Elizabeth Park Community and Cultural Centre (QEPCCC), located on Bridge Street in the Bronte neighbourhood of Oakville.

“We’ve run workshops at QEPCCC on multiple occasions,” said Lisa Michaels, Executive Director of Bandology. “So it’s really quite special to be able to bring the library here as well and to have an accessible and secure place that our instruments can call home.”

Bandology’s Instrument Lending Library is currently made up of more than 100 instruments, largely those relating to concert band, including instruments from the woodwinds, brass and percussion families. Instruments were acquired through the generosity of community members and two Capital Grants from the Ontario Trillium Foundation in previous years.

Instruments in the library are available to students in the area to borrow for a semester or over the summer. The program is designed to be accessible and open so that families facing barriers, whether financial or other, still have access to music education.
