Non-Profit Camp Announces Second Week With New Music Director

Oakville, Ontario, May 14, 2026 – Local non-profit Bandology is pleased to announce that they are hosting a second week of Band Camp in the Halton Region this summer. The organization, which has hosted a week of music camp in Halton since 2017, has added an August week in celebration of ten years of camp.

They will be welcoming Andrew Quinn on board to serve as their Music Director during the week of August 10-14. Quinn is a local music educator who works within the Halton District School Board. He holds a Bachelor of Music with an Honours Specialization in Music Education from the University of Western as well as a Bachelor of Education from York University.

“We’ve been asked for years to have more weeks of camp in Halton,” said Lisa Michaels, Executive Director and Co-Founder of Bandology. “We are really excited to respond to parent requests, plus it’s great to have Andrew join our team. It’s shaping up to be a wonderful summer for music making in Halton.”

Past directors for Band Camp Halton include Alecia Blackman, Head of Music at Bernie Custis Secondary School; Colin Clarke, Artistic Director of the Toronto Youth Wind Orchestra; David Lum, a Founding Director of the Ontario Band Association; and Ryan Meeboer, local composer and educator.

Bandology’s Band Camp runs in north Oakville from July 20-24 and August 10-14 at King’s Christian Collegiate. Band Camp is also offered in Kitchener-Waterloo during the week of July 6-10 and in Guelph from July 27-31.
